Mr. Holdren moved to draft a letter seeking extension of the Montour HOME Grant Agreement from May 15 to August 31. Mr. Finn seconded. The extension is necessary to finalize a project where a homeowner is refusing to sign completion paperwork. On called vote, all voted in favor.

Mr. Finn moved to approve a PCorp Loss Prevention Grant application of \$3,372.83 for the purchase of window coverings at the Prison as a security measure. Mr. Hartman seconded. On called vote, all voted in favor.

Mr. Hartman moved to affirm the hiring of Alexis Sciascia as Probation Officer at an annual salary of \$24,000.00 effective May 17. Mr. Finn seconded. On called vote, all voted in favor.

Mr. Hartman moved to pay the following bills: General Account, \$1,524,562.35; Children & Youth, \$49,275.42; Uniform 911, \$0; Human and Community Service, \$913.88; Facilities, \$15,966.00; Liquid Fuels, \$350.14; Other Funds, \$601,844.47. Mr. Finn seconded. On called vote, all voted in favor.
