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INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTER

1. TO VOTE YOU MUST BLACKEN THE OVAL (●) COMPLETELY. An oval (●) blackened to the left of the name of any candidate indicates a vote for that candidate.
2. To vote for a person whose name is NOT on the ballot, YOU MUST BLACKEN THE OVAL (●) completely to the left of the line provided, and write or print the name in the blank space provided for that purpose.
3. If you make a mistake, DO NOT ERASE. Ask for a new ballot.
4. USE ONLY THE MARKER PROVIDED.
5. DO NOT FOLD THE BALLOT unless voting mail-in/absentee.

WARNING: If you receive a mail-in/absentee ballot and return your voted ballot by the deadline, you may not vote at your polling place on election day. If you are unable to return your voted mail-in/absentee ballot by the deadline, you may only vote a provisional ballot at your polling place on election day, unless you surrender your mail-in/absentee ballot and the return envelope containing the Voter's Declaration to the judge of elections to be voided to vote by regular ballot.
